

- Few resubmissions after September's deadline







- Very few remaining issues, with some corrections needed

#### Submission Status and Timeline






Most of the blockers are due to a bug in CDR that prevented release before the resubmission deadline

#### Blockers


- Missing features from previous submissions (D03b)
- Activity period specification: Observing Capability vs OperationalActivity (D37b)



#### Errors

- SPO proximity to station (D36)
- Activity period specification (D37a, D45)


 Check that the total area covered by zones for each pollutant corresponds to the country extent (B21)





#### Errors

- Consistency with preliminary C (C03)
- Wrong threshold classification (C21)
- Assessment method not operational (C26)
- Missing Assessment Method (C40)
- Classification older than 5 years (C41)





- G14b Assessment Regimes not linked from C
- G89 Primary validated data must be submitted for all declared methods under Assessment Regime before releasing the Attainment.





- Major work was done on models:

  - new checks will be implemented (presented in the 1st day of the TIPR)
  - Eb43– Missing projection file .prj for shapefile submissions– also technical
