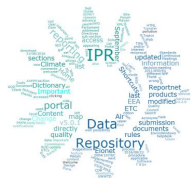
# 1 Preliminary B-C submission

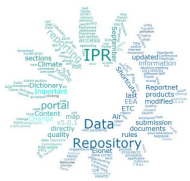
- To Comply with Directive

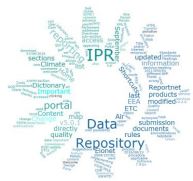

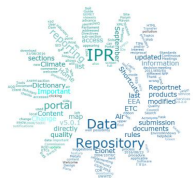
## 2 Why are B/C preliminary crucial?

- Comply with Directive
- Ensure that the monitoring network is place & adequate
- Early warning if you need to work on modelling/Objective



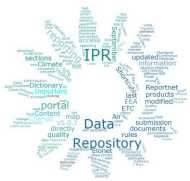
## 2 Why are B/C preliminary crucial?

- Early warning if you need to update 5 year Assessment Classification
- IDENTIFY key stations that DATA QUALITY OBJECTIVES MUST BE MET
- IDENTIFY ZONES which might require extra monitoring



## 2 Why are B/C preliminary crucial?

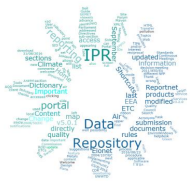
- Zone A
  - Levels > Upper Assessment Threshold
  - Due to population, 3 sampling points are required



## 2 Why are B/C preliminary crucial?

- Zone A
  - Levels > Upper Assessment Threshold
  - Due to population, 3 sampling points are required
- Case 1: there are 5 sampling points – should not “worry”
- Case 2: there are 3 sampling points, but 1 equipment is old and I keep sending to maintenance – DO WORRY!!!
- Case 3: there are only 2 sampling points, I need a third one



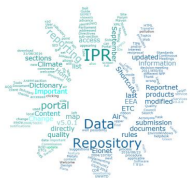


### 3 What to report?

#### Data flows preliminary B and preliminary C

pB → pC

The same sequence rules apply to delivery of preliminary B and preliminary C data flows. Please note that in this case, QA on preliminary C will be done on the basis of the information of the latest D/D1b delivered.

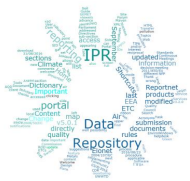

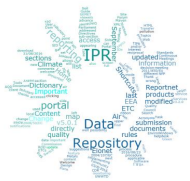

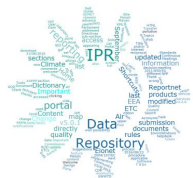
